2. Minutes of the Committee Meeting

3. Matters Arising

Charities Application

After the successful application for the club to be recognized as a Charity the committee recognized that there are a number of changes to be put in place.

- A standard Gift Aid form must be produced for members to 'gift aid' their subscriptions, it was recognized that there are a few people who are currently 'Non active' and it was felt that only active members should be given the form to complete.
- 2. It recognised that a new set of rules would have to be created to allow the club to work in harmony with the Charitable status. It was agreed that these rules should be drawn up by the current Trustees.
- 3. The Trustees could only stand for 2 years, but can be re-elected if they choose to stand and the members are in agreement.
- 4. It is believed that the club finances should now be audited annually.
